



- ♥ Children's bereavement Support Program is a 6 week program for children from ages 6 to 12 .
- ♥ Parent/Guardian Group meets while the children's program is in progress. Adults are able to gain new ideas from other participants, discuss productive ways of supporting the grieving children, and refine communication for the whole family.
- ♥ Children's grief depends on their development level and their family situation.
- ♥ Children are similar to adults in that their grief is real and intense. However, children may show their grief differently by repeatedly grieving in bursts of time and often expressing their grief through play.

- ♥ Children in grief deserve to be listened to, have their feelings validated, and be given the opportunity to play with other children who have suffered deaths.
- ♥ The basis of the Ridge Meadows Hospice Society children's bereavement program is respect – respect for children's response to death, respect for their right to mourn, and respect for their uniqueness as individuals.
- ♥ Children in grief often feel different from their friends. The opportunity to play with peers who have experienced similar losses can be very beneficial.



- ♥ Creative activities can assist children to cope with the death of someone they love by allowing them to express complicated emotions without words.
- ♥ Through colouring, painting, interactive story -telling, circle discussions and more, children can express and learn to understand their grief.
